WINTER EMERGENCY KIT

- Blanket
- Extra clothing, hat, mitts and boots
- Wind-up flashlight or flashlight with extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Seatbelt cutter
- Small shovel, scraper and snow brush
- Candle in a deep can and matches
- Sand, salt or cat litter (non-clumping)
- Antifreeze and windshield washer fluid
- Tow rope or chain
- Jumper cables
- Road flares
- Food that won't spoil, such as energy bars
- Water in bottles that won't break if the water freezes
- Extra medication
- Whistle to attract attention
- Phone charger
- List of emergency contacts
