# ENVIRONMENTAL, TRADES AND TECHNOLOGY ONTARIO COLLEGE CERTIFICATE

This full-time program, offered evenings and weekends, provides the skills to obtain the Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA) Gas Technician III and Gas Technician II certifications. Students will gain the knowledge required to work in the gas service industry. This program blends theory and practice and prepares students to write the provincial TSSA exams. Students can purchase their own manual and code book through Georgian Stores.

## **GAS TECHNICIAN III**

To write the Gas Technician III exam as provided by TSSA, students must take the following courses and apply to write the exam.

#### **GAS TECHNICIAN II**

Students with a Gas Technician III licence may apply to write the Gas Technician II exam as provided by TSSA. after successful completion of the six mandatory courses. These full-time Part-time Studies courses are offered evenings and weekends. It is recommended students take GAST1004, GAST1006 and GAST1009 before completing the other courses. Students must complete all required Gas Technician II courses over two semesters and apply to write the TSSA exam.

After successful completion of the second semester and all six mandatory courses, students are eligible to write the Gas II exam.

#### GAS TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE (Ontario College Certificate)

To receive the Gas Technician Certificate, students are required to complete two communications courses and two general education courses in addition to the Gas Technician III Certificate and the Gas Technician II Certificate courses. Student can still write the TSSA exams without completing General Education and Communications courses.
