# What are the varying forms of delivery?

This program is delivered through GC Flex.

All courses will be delivered in-person in Port Elgin.

Why is this program delivered using GC Flex? This gives students the choice to study in-person, online virtually or online asynchronously.


### What is GC Flex?

A GC Flex course means faculty deliver lectures and labs in the classroom and simultaneously online.

This means the course has a day and a time so that students can come in person, they can watch the lecture live virtually during the class time OR they can take the course asynchronously. All students are in the same section. You just study the way that works best for you.

Students wanting to study online asynchronously – PLEASE NOTE – because these courses are delivered in 3 different methods, the course you register into will show a day and time – if you choose to study asynchronously, you are not required to attend live classes, either virtually or on-campus but you MAY be required to be online at certain times to attend live group work or presentations or for tests/exams.



# What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time. As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester. Payment is per course, as you register.
