

Non-Academic prerequisites

**The deadline for Winter placements is November 30th
for Summer and Fall placements it is March 31st**

- **Standard First Aid/CPR (minimum level C) certification**
 - Minimum 16 hour course – see list below of local training agencies
- **Health & Safety Awareness training**
 - All Ontario employers now require Health & Safety training
 - If you believe you have this training already, bring your certificate to B200
 - note: it is not WHMIS training
 - Free online training <http://www.labour.gov.on.ca/english/hs/elearn/worker/index.php>
 - Takes approximately 45 minutes to complete (tip – you cannot not skip the videos!)
 - You must save or print the certificate as soon as it is completed
 - Add a copy to your portfolio and list it on your resume
- **Completed Immunization form**
 - The Georgian college immunization form is available in B200 Orillia campus or online at <http://www.georgiancollege.ca/admissions/forms/placement-requirement-forms-tab/>
 - You may need to update vaccinations/boosters that were done before 2008
