2022-23 Audited Financial Statements

At the conclusion of every fiscal year, the college produces financial statements. The statements are audited by Georgian's external auditors. They're then presented to the Finance and Audit Committee of the board for its review. The committee then determines if the statements should be recommended to the board for its acceptance.

The statements were approved at the June 8 board meeting and will become the official financial record of the college and are forwarded to the Ministry of Colleges and Universities.

Board Scorecard

The Board Scorecard is updated on a quarterly basis, as data becomes available. The scorecard supports the board's ability to simultaneously assess the performance of several areas of the college. The reporting of two metrics with scheduled updates for June were deferred, and 11 metrics in total were updated for the June Board Scorecard.

Annual Report

The Ministry of Colleges and Universities requires each college to prepare an annual report that assesses the college's achievement of its annual business plan commitments and includes the audited financial statements. A key purpose of the annual report is to demonstrate public accountability.
