## BARRIE CAMPUS

### SERVICE FUNDAMENTALS CAMPUS TOUR (45 minutes)

This tour highlights Georgian's student services (e.g., Registrar's Office, student benefits plan, learning supports, etc.) as well as key campus features (e.g., library, cafeteria, Athletic and Fitness Centre).

Ideal for those who haven't applied and want to see available services.

### CAMPUS HIGHLIGHTS TOUR (45 minutes to one hour)

This tour covers each building on campus and showcases experiential learning opportunities for Georgian students. Expect to see labs, clinics, wood shops, as well as cool spaces that highlight our commitment to entrepreneurship and social innovation.

Ideal for those who want to see what hands-on learning looks like, and features that set Georgian apart.

### DESIGN AND VISUAL ARTS TOUR - 1 Georgian Drive (30 to 45 minutes)

This tour features unique learning spaces specific to Design and Visual Arts programs.

Expect to see spaces such as the campus art gallery, 3D studio, printmaking studio, jewellery and fine metals workroom, and more.

#### Optional extension to Design and Digital Arts Centre at 5 Ross St, Barrie. (30 minutes plus travel time. Transportation required)

Expect to see state-of-the-art studios, work and learning spaces created for the following programs: Digital Video, Graphic Design, Graphic Design Production, and Photography

### MEDICAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY TOUR (35 to 45 minutes)

This tour features unique learning spaces specific to Health, Wellness and Sciences programs, as well as some key campus features.

Expect to see nursing labs, paramedic simulator and training facility, pharmacy lab, speech, hearing and language clinic, and more.

### ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGIES AND SKILLED TRADES TOUR (30 to 45 minutes)

This tour introduces visitors to engineering and environmental technologies and skilled trades programs at Georgian.

Features a tour of labs for manufacturing design, high-voltage electrical, innovative technology, precision skills, woodworking, and more.

### BUSINESS AND MANAGEMENT AND COMPUTER STUDIES TOUR (30 to 40 minutes)

This tour highlights the array of business and management and computer studies programs offered at Georgian, along with examples of how students learn.

Expect to see computer labs and unique spaces created to foster the entrepreneurial spirit of Georgian students.

### HOSPITALITY, TOURISM AND RECREATION (30 to 45 minutes)

This tour takes you through the many ways in which Georgian students have the opportunity for hands-on learning within hospitality, tourism and recreation programs.

Expect to see culinary labs, student-run food service outlets, golf lab, athletic testing centre, and more.

### DEGREE STUDIES AT GEORGIAN (40 to 50 minutes)

This tour takes you through the learning spaces of the degree programs offered at Georgian.
