Electric vehicle charging stations - powered by our own solar panels!

If you drive by the Barrie Campus, you might notice three large solar panels. We're able to power several electric vehicle charging stations, as well as our Alectra Centre for Research, Innovation and Commercialization with renewable solar energy, stored in our microgrid.

Students even have the chance to work with the microgrid to help reduce our carbon footprint! They can track the data, analyze usage and apply what they learn in class to a highly advanced electrical system.

E Experimenting with our microgrid system gives students an opportunity to tackle issues like reducing greenhouse gases through an innovative approach. This technology is more than just for faculty; we want students to explore and be part of real-world scenarios.

RESEARCH, INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Bee hotels and flourishing gardens - right on campus!

Over the last few years, Georgian's culinary programs have been cooking up some projects.

- Bun on the Run takeout food service: Hospitality students create the food and serve it in reusable containers with bamboo cutlery, reducing single-use plastics.
- Garden: We plant a variety of produce that's used in student learning and on-campus dining rooms. Any extra food goes to the Georgian Food Locker for students in need.
- Orchard: Pear, cherry and apple trees were planted to lower carbon emissions.
- Beehives and bee domiciles: The domicile is a home for native pollinators, while beehives were brought in to produce honey for the college.

In all of Georgian's culinary programs, students work on their own sustainability projects, practise their research, innovation and entrepreneurial skills and then apply that learning when they graduate.

WHAT YOU NEED TO GET IN

Admission requirements are different for each program. Find program-specific requirements on pages 30 to 32 of this book and online at GeorgianCollege.ca/full-time-programs. You'll also need to take the following steps to get into Georgian:

STUDENT CATEGORY	BASIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
High school students	You need to complete your high school diploma. If you receive a conditional acceptance, make sure you meet requirements before starting at Georgian. Requirements could include passing courses, maintaining your grades, and more.
Mature applicants	 If you'll be 19 years of age or older as of the first day of classes at Georgian and don't have a high school diploma, you can apply as a mature student. Here are way you meet requirements: Take courses at an Independent Learning Centre or another site recognized by the Ministry of Education. Take an English or math equivalency test through GeorgianCollege.ca/testing-services (not applicable to degrees). Take equivalent credit courses at Georgian or another recognized college or university.
Applicants from postsecondary institutions	If you've taken courses from another accredited postsecondary institution, you may meet admission requirements and be eligible for transfer credits. Visit GeorgianCollege.ca/CPL to learn more. If you have a degree or diploma, our one-year graduate certificates can help fast-track you into the workplace. Visit GeorgianCollege.ca/gradcerts to learn more.
English as a Second Language applicants	 The language of instruction at Georgian College is English. In addition to the academic admission requirements, all applicants for whom English is not their first language and/or are coming from countries where English is not an official language, must provide proof of language proficiency. Applicants must have ONE of the following criteria to meet Georgian's language proficiency requirements: Must have completed three full years of study at a secondary school (high school) level in English in a country where English is a primary language (four years are required for BScN, Pharmacy Technician and Addictions: Treatment and Prevention. Study must be in Canada only for Pharmacy Technician and Addictions: Treatment and Prevention. Study in an accredited postsecondary program in English in a country where English is a primary language (not applicable for BScN, Pharmacy Technician and Addictions: Treatment and Prevention) OR Must have an Ontario Secondary Diploma (or Canadian provincial equivalent) and English credit (Grade 12 U, M or C) issued by a public or Catholic school board (not applicable to BScN, Pharmacy Technician and Addictions: Treatment and Prevention) OR Must provide proof of graduation from one of the authorized Georgian College partner school pathway programs (not applicable to HSN or Pharmacy Technician) OR Must have completed three years of study at a secondary private school in Ontario and received an Ontario Secondary School Diploma and English credit (Grade 12 U, M or C) Note: International students applying through the Study Direct Stream (SDS) program from Antigua and Barbuda, Brazil, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, India, Morocco, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Senegal, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, or Vietnam should note that the SDS IELTS requirements are 6.0 with no score less than 6.0 in any of the four bands for programs listing a higher IELTS admission. Priority for applicants will be given to those who meet

Apply for college

Apply online through the International Application System (IAS) international.ontariocolleges.ca/applicant, where you can find program availability. If you're applying through an agent, please apply through international.ontariocolleges.ca/agent. Program availability varies by intake. Visit GeorgianCollege.ca/international for details. Applicants are urged to apply as early as possible to ensure there's sufficient time to obtain a study permit/student VISA.

Include your documentation

Include English language test scores, academic records and other translated documentation. Proof of graduation, subjects taken and grades received are required.

Accept your offer

You (or your representative) will receive an email through the International Application System (IAS) with our admission decision and next steps. When an offer is issued, you can accept it immediately. Timeline for letters of acceptance can vary depending on time of year and application volumes.

Pay your deposit

To secure a seat in your program, please submit your tuition deposit (minimum \$2,500 CAD via FlyWire) by the deadline on your offer letter. Once your deposit is processed, you'll receive a letter of acceptance (needed for study permit application).

Apply for your study permit/student VISA

Once you have the letter of acceptance and a tuition deposit receipt, you should apply for your study permit/ student VISA as soon as possible so that you can obtain the VISA document to start your program on time. Once you have received your student VISA, you must upload it to the International Application System (IAS) portal before you can register for your courses.
