When can I start taking G3 courses?

September

Do I need to apply?

Part-time students must apply to this program through <u>ontariocolleges.ca</u> Use the code GASX.

Admission requirements are available on the program outline.

How many courses do I need to take?

Students wishing to complete G3 and G2 take the following courses:

What is the cost of the program?

Students who are taking G3 and G2 courses pay program tuition.

2023-2024 tuition plus fees (your fees may vary from that listed below) \$2944.20 (Fall) \$2664.10 (Winter) \$2664.10 (Summer)

Textbook fees are not included in the tuition and must be purchased separately. TSSA certification testing can be taken at Georgian and there is an additional fee for the exam(s).

What is the schedule? Are classes in the evening?

Your schedule will include classes on week nights and Saturdays. Week night classes begin at 6pm and Saturdays usually start at 8am.

The number of evenings/hours on Saturdays varies semester to semester. Typically you will be attending 3 evenings per week plus a full day or partial day on Saturday.

Can I take the G3 courses only?

G3 courses are offered in the Fall semester only (September-December). If you do not wish to continue with G2 courses, that is ok.

You can take G3 courses and then come back to complete the G2 courses at any time.

I have a G3 and want to take the G2 courses only? What is the process?

Students with a valid G3 license are eligible to start taking G2 courses in the Winter semester. Please connect with the Program Coordinator, Morten Rapp, as the application process is different and you will need confirmation that you are eligible.
