- Based on the program of study and semester organization, students who have successfully completed semester 1, may wish to write the Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)[®] Certification Examination.
- Based on the program of study and semester organization, students who have successfully completed semester 2, may wish to write the Project Management Professional (PMP)[®] Certification Examination.

What are the varying forms of delivery?

This will run as dual synchronous learning, where learning is planned and delivered for in-person. Students can have the option to attend virtually in real time if needed using technology such as MS Teams or Web Ex.

How do I know which courses to take?

The Port Elgin location will have 2 courses running each semester. In order to finish the program in Port Elgin, students will need to commit to taking the 2 courses each semester as we will only have one intake in May 2024.

What is the cost of the program?
