### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Do I need to apply?

Part-time students must apply to this program through <u>ontariocolleges.ca</u> Use the code RAPX.

#### When can I start the program?

Intakes: September and January

#### How many courses do I take?

Graduation requirements: 12 Program Courses, 1 Co-op Work Term

#### Are courses delivered in the evening? Online?

Part-time students enrolled in the Research Analyst Graduate Certificate take courses along with the full-time students. There are no courses specifically scheduled in the evening. Typically classes are scheduled during the day. Some courses are offered online.

#### How long will it take to complete the certificate?

12 courses plus co-op work term
Fall intake
3 courses per semester

Under 2 years (1 year, 8 months)

Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter (includes co-op in final Winter semester)

2 courses per semester

2 years

Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer (includes co-op in final Summer semester)

#### What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time. As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester. Payment is per course, as you register.
