- Grade 12 college or Grade 11 or 12 university Biology (SBI3U, SBI4U, SBI3C)
- Grade 12 college or Grade 11 or 12 university Chemistry (SCH4C, SCH4U, SCH3U) or
- Grade 12 college or Grade 11 or 12 university Physics (SPH3U, SPH4C, SPH4U)
