\*GNED 1047 is equivalent to GNED 2072 Environmental Citizenship . If you have already successfully completed or received a transfer credit for GNED 2072, please do not register for GNED 1047 as it will not count as another GNED credit towards your Program requirements.

\*PSYL 1021 is equivalent to PSYL 1001 Intro to Psychology. If you have already successfully completed or received a transfer credit for PSYL 1001, please do not register for PSYL 1021 as it will not count as another GNED credit towards your Program requirements.

\*SOCL 1002 is equivalent to SOCL 1000 Intro to Sociology. If you have already successfully completed or received a transfer credit for SOCL 1000, please do not register for SOCL 1002 as it will not count as another GNED credit towards your Program requirements.

**(ODE)** in the course title - refers to Ontario Distance Education (Ontario Learn) courses. These are not delivered by Georgian, therefore COMM and GNED office is unable to support you with any technical needs or academic appeals with these courses. They come with an added cost.
