\*\*Are Courses offered through Part Time Studies. Students registering out of sequence, taking a course over and above the regular course load, or as a Part Time student (3 courses or less in the Fall Semester) can register for these courses starting August 2, 2023 (from any campus). All other courses - they would have to wait until Add/Drop (April 15 - May 17, 2024) provided there is still room in the course. It is advisable to be registered and attending classes at the start of the semester (May 6th), as starting late does put you at a disadvantage.
