\*\*GNED1083 and GNED1084 are Compressed 7 week courses. They are not through Blackboard, and grades may be delayed (if you are in a program that requires grades for Board exams, please check with the Reg. Office if timing of this course is acceptable to meet those deadlines).

Please refer to MyPath, or seek advice from a student advisor if you have taken courses previously at Georgian (or Ontario Learn) to ensure you are not taking the same course again (Course codes may be different, but equivalent). If you have courses from another College of University, and are interested in having them evaluated for credit transfer, it is best to do this early (before the semester starts), and submit course outlines along with the credit transfer request to the Credit Transfer Centre.
