Use the code AUBO.

Do I have to do Co-op Work Terms as a part-time student?

Yes, Co-op Work Terms are part of the graduation requirements for all students.

What does online mean?

The online courses listed in the [Delivery Schedule](#) document displays when courses are offered online *asynchronous* which means no live classes. You can log in to the course whenever it works best for you. Most courses have weekly deadlines you will have to meet. Classes are delivered combining self-directed lectures, group discussions and virtual instructor support.

You will not be required to be on campus for any part of the course – all lectures, tests, exams are online.

What are the varying forms of remote delivery? (applicable for Fall 2021 – you may see these types of scheduling in Winter and Summer)

In Winter 2022, some programs at Georgian College are continuing with online delivery. We have different categories of online – please use the guide below when you are searching for an ONLINE course (see asynchronous definition)

O-SLINE: Synchronous, meaning all students need to log on and participate at the day and time listed on your timetable.

Online: Asynchronous, meaning you can log onto the course whenever it works best for you.

O-BLINE: Bichronous, meaning your course(s) will be scheduled as synchronous, though will operate mostly asynchronously. Communicated by professor via Blackboard.



Georgian will cover the cost of the \$95 Ontario College Application Service (OCAS) fee, all other Georgian fees are still applicable.

How long will it take to complete the diploma?

This varies depending on how many courses you take each semester. Total courses: 24

3 courses per semester: finish in 8 semesters or 2.5 years

Example: Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter

2 courses per semester: finish in 12 semesters or 4 years

Example: Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer

What happens if I cannot take any courses one semester due to other commitments/circumstances?

You do not have to report or confirm the number of courses you take each semester – this is up to you and you can change the number of courses you take from semester to semester.

For example, you can start with 2 courses, then take 3 courses, then take 2 courses, etc. Remember that if you are not able to maintain a minimum 2 courses per semester, it will delay your timeline to completion.

You can take one semester off per year from taking courses if required. If you need an extended time away, please connect with us to discuss.

Can I transfer credits/use prior learning to fast track?

The Credit Transfer Centre (CTC) assists with:

- Transferring courses completed at another accredited institution which may be eligible for transfer towards your education at Georgian.
- Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) – students can challenge course requirements based on relevant work or life skills and knowledge gained.

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time.

As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester.

Payment is per course, as you register. The course fees change year-to-year and course to course.
