**Timelines**

With a Winter start:

**2 courses every semester** – finish in 4 years (12 semesters)

Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall-Winter-Summer-Fall

**3 courses every semester** – finish in 2.5 years (8 semesters)
