Do I need to apply?



How long will it take to complete the certificate?

This varies depending on how many courses you take each semester. Total courses: 15

Following the delivery schedule which is 3 courses per semester plus 2 courses per semester: finish in 6 semesters (3 years) Example: Fall – Winter – Fall – Winter – Fall – Winter (there are no classes offered in the summer)

In this program, part-time students can take 1, 2, 3 or 4 courses per semester and remain part-time.

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time.

As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester. Payment is per course, as you register.

Using an analysis of professional video projects, students apply the fundamentals of video capture from storyboarding to editing to create a digital video project.
