How long will it take to complete the certificate?

This varies depending on how many courses you take each semester. Total courses: 12 plus Field Placement

Following the Delivery Schedule:

3 courses per semester – 4 semesters or 2 years

Fall – Winter – Fall – Winter

What is the cost of the program?

There is no program fee when studying part-time. As a part-time student, you can take 1, 2 or 3 courses at a time in any given semester.

Payment is per course, as you register.
