



## GENERAL CARPENTER (403A) APPRENTICESHIP

Earn while you learn as an apprentice

Apprenticeships are workplace-based training programs. The Georgian College Muskoka Campus offers the in-school portion of training for final certification for existing general carpenter apprentices.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Currently employed in the trade and formally registered as an apprentice – contact the apprenticeship office for admission requirements.

### INTERESTED IN APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING?

#### STEP ONE

Find an employer who will agree to hire/train you.

#### STEP TWO

Together with your employer, you'll meet with a Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU) training consultant who determines if the agreed-upon training will meet all apprenticeship requirements.

Working with your employer, sponsor and MCU, you'll complete on-the-job training and in-school training at Georgian; MCU determines when you'll attend the in-school portion of training.

### BASIC PROGRAM (LEVEL ONE)

Proposed date: Oct. 19 to Dec. 11, 2020

Fee: \$400\*

Prerequisite: Grade 10 or equivalent

### INTERMEDIATE PROGRAM (LEVEL TWO)

Proposed date: March 8 to April 30, 2021

Fee: \$400\*

Prerequisite: Level two standing

### ADVANCED PROGRAM (LEVEL THREE)

Proposed date: Jan. 4 to March 5, 2021

Fee: \$450\*

Prerequisite: Level three standing
