- Any Grade 11 or 12 Mathematics (C, M or U)

Mature students, non-secondary school applicants (19 years of age or older), and home school applicants may also be considered for admission. Eligibility may be met by applicants who have taken equivalent courses, upgrading, completed their GED, or equivalency testing.
