



2022-23 Work-Study Program Application for Students

Purpose

Work Study is a financial assistance program administered by Financial Aid and Awards in the Office of the Registrar. It subsidizes student wages for part-time jobs on campus. This “earn while you learn” program assists you with your education and living costs, while providing you with quality work experiences within one of the many College departments or academic areas.

Value

The funding for Work Study contributes towards your student access guarantee. When you are hired into a Work Study position, your salary is subsidized up to a maximum of \$6,000 (up to \$2,000 per student, per term).

Eligibility Requirements

In order to qualify, student must:

- Be registered as a full-time student (includes co-op) at Georgian College*
- Be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or protected person
- Have an OSAP assessment (or other Canadian provincial government student loan), or demonstrate financial need (student must complete the Work Study Application)
- Are not currently working in another Work Study position (students can only be funded for one Work Study position per term)

*Lakehead-Georgian and ILAC students are not eligible for this program.
